1. Polero Sauvignon Blanc (Chile) £4.75 £5.75 £17.00

Zingy, zesty mouth watering fruit make this wine a real joy to drink. What more do you want?

2. Parlare Pinot Grigio (Italy) £4.75 £6.00 £18.00

Light and crisp with Granny Smith apple flavours.

3. McGuigan Single Batch Chardonnay (Australia) £18.00

Light oak, citrus and stone fruit aromas. Peach, nectarine and pear flavours on the palate.

McGuigan Black Label Chardonnay (Australia) £4.75

A flavoursome wine with a soft, smooth creamy palate.

4. Tempus Two Silver Series Pinot Gris (Australia) £21.00

Rich in stone fruit, pear and baked apple characters accompanied by a crisp acidic backbone.

5. Marques de Caceres Sauvignon Blanc (Spain) £24.00

Complex bouquet with exotic fruit. Clean and lively in the mouth with a pleasant minerality. Long finish.

6. The Crossings Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) £25.00

Gooseberry, passion fruit, peach and green pepper harmonise with good balance. "IWSC Trophy for Best Sauvignon Blanc in the World 2013"

Brancott Estate Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) £6.00

New Zealand in a glass. Citrus and hints of grass with a reviving fresh finish.

7. Ropiteau Chablis A.C. (Burgundy, France) £35.00

Rich, and golden with notes of apple and honey.

9. Polero Merlot (Chile) £4.75 £5.75 £17.00

Smooth soft style Merlot with lots of spice on the finish.

10. Camina Cabernet Sauvignon (Spain) £4.75 £6.00 £18.00

Aromas of berries and ripe red fruit that has robust varietal characteristics with a complex body.

11. McGuigan Single Batch Shiraz (Australia) £4.75 £6.25 £19.00

A soft, fruit driven wine showing typical Shiraz richness reined in by the soft tannin finish. A deliciously soft style of wine.

12. Cigar Box Malbec (Mendoza, Argentina) £24.00

This wine stands out for its meatiness and intense rich flavour whilst the soft, silky finish balances the overall experience.

13. Ropiteau Cotes du Rhone Villages (France) £24.00

Purplish red. Fresh and intense, citrus and fruit drop candies. Characterful and elegant on the palate with flavours of fruit drop candies (blackcurrant, raspberry) echoed.

14. Marques De Caceres Crianza, D.O. Rioja (Spain) £26.00

Cherry and blackberry aromas with luscious red berry fruits and silky tannins with a long, spicy finish.

15. The Crossings Pinot Noir (N. Zealand) £30.00

Ripe berry fruit flavours combined with savoury notes on the palate.

16. Guigal Crozes Hermitage Rouge (France) £35.00

A structured tannic wine with aromas of blackcurrant buds, vanilla and remarkable freshness.
